Message from Rabbi Yaron Kapitulnik

The annual meeting of Temple Judea is, for me, a sacred ritual, a moment to pause, reflect honestly on the year behind us, and offer gratitude for the community that makes all of it possible. As this fiscal year comes to a close, I find myself returning again and again to the theme that guided us this year: Conversations That Matter.

In a world that rewards noise over nuance and speed over substance, Temple Judea made a different choice this year. We chose to slow down. To sit across from one another. To ask harder questions and truly listen to the answers. In our classrooms, our lunch and learn gatherings, our social justice work, and with every scholar that challenged us - the conversations we had this year mattered. They mattered because they were honest, because they were grounded in our tradition, and because they reminded us that the greatest gift a congregation can

offer its members is the experience of feeling genuinely heard.

It would be impossible to reflect on this year without celebrating two remarkable colleagues who completed their first full year at Temple Judea - and made an extraordinary impact in the process. Rabbi Wendy Pein brought to our congregation a love of Torah and a gift for creating the kind of learning environment where real conversation flourishes. Among her many accomplishments this year, Meet the Rabbi's Round Table stands out as something truly special - an ongoing series of open, intimate gatherings where congregants were invited to bring any question: theological, personal, or spiritual. No agenda, no filters. Just honest dialogue rooted in Jewish wisdom.

Rabbi Pein also brought Torah study back to in-person gatherings with a fresh energy, introduced a vibrant

new curriculum to our school, and enriched our adult learning landscape through thoughtful Lunch and Learns, meaningful Rosh Chodesh groups, and a Women's Seder that left a deep and lasting impression on all who participated. Temple Judea is a richer place because of her presence.

Cantorial Soloist Kaylene Cole completed her first full year on our team, and the word that comes to mind most readily is: extraordinary. Kaylene attended her first national cantorial conference this year, deepening her craft and bringing back new energy and ideas. She introduced beautiful new music into our worship life- melodies that have already become part of who we are. Her special Broadway Shabbat and Barbara Streisand Shabbat left us all in awe. She launched Music Together, a growing program that is building community and love of Jewish music among our families. Her Hanukkah concert was unforgettable. And the care and musical investment she brings to every Bar and Bat Mitzvah student has elevated that sacred journey for each family she touches. Kaylene,

this congregation is so much richer for having you at its heart.

This was also a year of continued and remarkable growth for Temple Judea. Our congregation has expanded - in membership, in the reach of our programs, and in the depth of our community bonds. It also looks so much better after significant renovations, new chairs and an overall "facelift." This growth is a reflection of each member who serves as an ambassador for this temple, who brings a neighbor or a friend and says simply: come, just try it once.

None of this is possible without leadership that matches our ambition with steadiness. To Keith Paulus, completing his first year as president - thank you. You brought to this role integrity, calm, and a genuine love of this congregation. You inherited momentum and sustained it. You met challenges with grace. It is an honor to work alongside you.

And to Morli Fidler, our Executive Director - I have said it before, and I will say again; cemeteries are full

of people who were considered irreplaceable. I hold that to be true as a general matter, with one exception: what Morli brings to this temple. Her ability to hold every moving part of this institution together, with professionalism, warmth, and an unwavering devotion to Temple Judea - it is a gift beyond measure.

Message from Rabbi Wendy Pein

*Reflections on Jewish
Learning
at Temple Judea*

During a YEP class exploring what it means to be Jewish – our customs, our rituals, our texts – a kindergartener looked up and said simply, “I want to do that. I want to do all of it.” That sentence has stayed with me all year, not only because of what it revealed about one child, but because I have seen that same spark in so many places at Temple Judea: in the adults who fill our Shabbat Torah study, in the teens who ask to learn more, and in the families who entrust us with their children’s Jewish futures. Jewish learning at TJ is not just a program. It is something that animates our community at every age. As I write this, our YEP students have been learning about Passover – a holiday whose central commandment is to tell the story of a people who, generation after generation, have faced challenge and still chosen to work toward a world of justice, compassion, and hope. One of the most sacred things we do as a community is invite our children into that living story.

This year, I saw that invitation embraced across every age and grade. In our 4th and 5th grade classes, students explored Jewish role models across history through the lens of *Lo Alecha* – “It is not your obligation to complete the work, but neither are you free to desist from it.” Their teacher described a defining moment: a student connected a passage about responsibility to helping a struggling friend, and the room shifted. In that moment, students began to understand that

Jewish texts are not only meant to be studied, but to be lived.

In 6th grade, students preparing for B’nei Mitzvah studied entire books of Torah – for many, the first time engaging Torah itself, and not only stories about it. We marked each book’s completion with a *siyum*, a celebration of communal learning and an experience we hope they will carry forward into Jewish adulthood. Perhaps the moment that moved me most came from our Madrichim, our teen leaders. When they asked to learn together more regularly, we began meeting on Sundays over lunch to study the weekly parashah. From that learning, the teens went on to plan and lead a full Jewish Field Day – a Maccabiah – for our younger students. That is the Jewish story alive in our hallways.

This year, we were also proud to introduce the ISJL (Institute for Southern Jewish Life) Education Curriculum, joining 72 partner congregations nationwide. Built as a spiraled learning experience, the curriculum returns students to core Jewish themes each year with greater depth, drawing on music, art, storytelling, and drama. Its goal is not only to transmit knowledge, but to help each child find their place within the Jewish story.

Jewish learning at Temple Judea does not end at bar or bat mitzvah; it deepens over time. This year offered two vivid examples. First, our Shabbat morning Torah Study returned to being fully in person, and the response has exceeded every expectation. The music room,

our usual gathering place, often overflows. What was once necessarily limited on Zoom has become something richer: a true encounter with text and with one another, as members bring their backgrounds, insights, and life experience to the conversation. That spirit of learning extends naturally into our Shabbat kiddush afterward, creating a fuller sense of Jewish life on Shabbat morning.

We are also concluding this year’s Lunch and Learn series on Reform Responsa, in which we wrestled with real questions: How do we honor Shabbat in a Reform Jewish community? What is our relationship to the secular calendar? Should the tragedy of the Holocaust shape the way we think about Jewish law and practice? These are not abstract questions. They are real questions about Jewish life in 2026. Next year, I am excited to offer two new courses: a Jewish 101 series for those seeking a deeper grounding in our texts and traditions, and a course exploring what it means to fulfill the commandment to “love your neighbor as yourself” – beginning with the work of learning to love ourselves.

None of this happens without people who show up with dedication and care. I am grateful to our staff, our teachers, our Madrichim, and our clergy – Rabbi Yaron and Cantorial Soloist Kaylene – as well as to Morli Fidler, our Executive Director. Most of all, I am grateful to our families and adult learners, who trust us with their children’s Jewish futures and with their own Jewish growth.

Next year, we will deepen our work with the ISJL curriculum, expand teen engagement, and offer new opportunities for adult learning. Most of all, I look forward

“Shiru l’Adonai, shir chadash” – sing to Adonai a new song. This line comes from Psalm 96 from our Kabbalat Shabbat liturgy. In many ways, I have felt like this psalm has been so representative of my first full year at TJ. make music, to express ourselves creatively – but I also wanted to deepen my personal relationships with them all and I truly felt I had (and continue to do so) by the end of it. Our season kicked off with so many beautiful moments including one that I know will remain a personal favorite: Barbra Streisand Shabbat. During this special service, we welcomed Shabbat in with many beloved songs of hers. It was an evening of spirituality and creativity fused in a lovely way.

As I think about this year, there is so much gratitude that I feel towards so many people, and I would be remiss to not mention them personally. It has been a wonderful year growing in my role alongside my fellow Clergy members Rabbi Yaron and Rabbi Wendy. They both continue to not only mentor me with their actions and the way they carry themselves - professionally and personally. They also generously share their wealth of knowledge whenever I need it. I could not do what I do every day without the incredible support of our office staff. Morli goes above and beyond every single day to make sure that everything runs as it should (I have been instructed by her to keep this

It is my honor to present this Treasurer's Report as I complete my first year in this role. Serving this community has been a privilege, and I am deeply grateful for the trust you have placed in me. As I reflect on this past year, I am struck by the extraordinary generosity of our Temple Judea family. Time and again, our members have stepped forward with open hearts and open hands - and we are truly blessed to be part of such a remarkable and giving community. Thank you for your continued support and dedication to Temple Judea.

MEMBERSHIP:

Temple Judea continues to maintain a strong membership base, allowing us to sustain our community and services. We had budgeted for a net increase of +4 new members for the 2025/26 fiscal year. I am pleased to report that we are ending the year with a net increase of +12 new members, for a total of 717 paying households and 785 total member households, far exceeding our expectations. We are grateful to all families who have joined our temple community this fiscal year.

2025-2026 Treasurer's Report

DUES:

Temple Judea's primary source of income continues to be dues. Importantly, one of the core values of Temple Judea is to keep our doors open to anyone wishing to be a member, regardless of their ability to pay dues. We are very grateful to our members who continue to donate to our Chai and Golden Chai Societies, which go above and beyond their commitment to make this possible.

FUNDRAISING:

Temple Judea relies on its annual fundraising to help offset the difference in expenses versus dues collected. This year, thanks to our very successful High Holy Day appeal, we were able to end our fiscal year with a surplus which will be applied to our capital fund and our general reserves.

ENDOWMENT:

Temple Judea continues to partner with the Jewish Federation of Palm Beach County's Life and Legacy Program, securing endowment gifts which help secure the long-term financial future of the temple. I am proud to announce that our endowment has now surpassed \$6 million, representing a significant milestone in our financial sustainability.

We continue to extend our sincere thanks to all members who have made endowment commitments of any size, all of which help solidify our temple's future.

CAPITAL EXPENDITURES:

We have continued to maintain our facilities and address necessary capital improvements throughout the year. As you are aware, Temple Judea does not have a building fund, nor are members assessed for capital expenses. Instead, we either fund these improvements from our balance sheet and savings or receive generous designated gifts from our members.

This year, we are especially grateful to several members whose extraordinary generosity has allowed us to make significant improvements to our facilities:

- Rita Tansky for our social hall carpeting
- Beryl and Bob Schneider for our social hall paint and wallpaper
- Linda Teitelbaum for our social hall banquet chairs
- Terry and Frank Vaccaro for our new Minyan prayerbooks

These generous contributions have enhanced our physical space and the experience of all who enter our temple.

CLERGY TRANSITION:

This fiscal year saw transitions in our clergy, which resulted in lower personnel expenses than originally budgeted. While these transitions presented challenges, they also contributed to our financial surplus for the year. The board has been working diligently on succession planning to ensure the

continued spiritual leadership of our community.

DUES THIS UPCOMING FISCAL YEAR:

All current members (as of May 31, 2026) will be assessed a 3% increase in their current dues.

For any member who joins post June 1, 2026, we have two membership categories - single or family. The dues rate for this upcoming fiscal year will

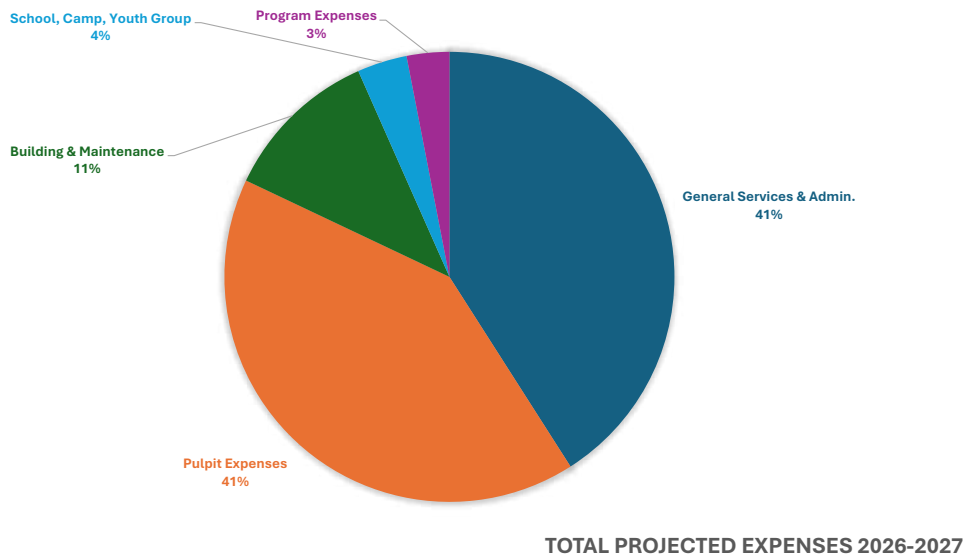
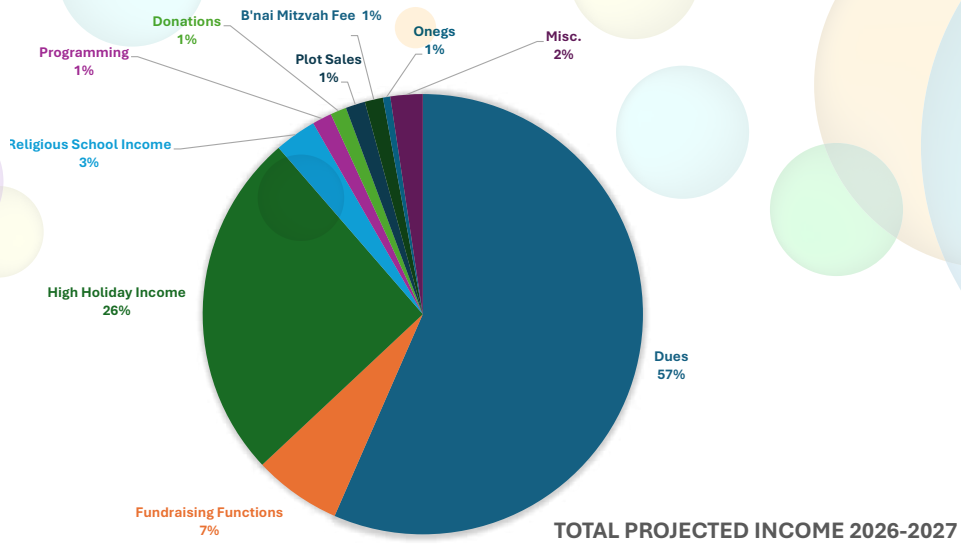
